Novice (7-9 yrs) £3.00 each entry(state Classical or Modern)

Definition of a Novice: A novice is a competitor aged between 7-9 yrs who has not won a place/medal in any solo class at a previous competition. Loss of status in one style shall not effect novice status in any other style. A competitor may not enter their chosen novice style in the open section of that style

Solos: £4.00 each entry

Duets: £3.00 per person

Trios + Quartets : £3.00 per person

Groups £2.00 per competitor

Miss/Mr Dance Heat £5.00 per competitor

To qualify for the final, competitors must be 16 years or over on 31 May and will be required to give a performance in Modern Dance (which shall include Tap if desired) max 3 minutes in which dance will dominate but which may include song, dialogue, instrumentation. Ideally the dance should not be the same dance prepared for 'E' modern.

Choreographic £4.00 each entry (Ages 11-21) Entries in the section may NOT be performed in the open sections. The dance created must be entirely the competitor's own choreographic work – assistance permitted with costume and music only. Choreographer(s) are required to submit a project which must be handed to the organisers on a day prior to the section being danced. ONE ENTRY PER CHOREOGRAPHER
